#### Dr. Robert Yarbrough

BA – Southwest Baptist College  
MA – Wheaton College Graduate School;  
PhD – University of Aberdeen

Dr. Yarbrough is currently Professor of New Testament at Covenant Theological Seminary and has taught at TEDS, Wheaton College and Liberty University. He has been involved in theological education in Muslim Africa and Eastern Europe and served on pastoral staffs in Montana, Missouri, North Carolina, and Illinois. Dr. Yarbrough has authored or co-edited the following:

- 1-3 John (2008) in the Baker Exegetical Commentary Series
- The commentary series, Exegetical Guide to the New Testament
- The Salvation-Historical Fallacy? Reassessing the History of New Testament Theology (2004)
- The textbook, Encountering the New Testament (3rd ed. 2013)
- The Kregel Pictorial Guide to the New Testament (2009)
- The Gospel of John (1991; revised edition 2011).

He has coached high school and American Legion baseball and worked professionally as a lumberjack in Montana and Idaho.

Dr. Payne is currently Adjunct Professor of New Testament Studies at Fuller Theological Seminary Northwest. He has taught New Testament at Cambridge University Colleges, Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary and Bethel Theological Seminary. He is an ordained minister of the Evangelical Free Church of America. He and his wife Nancy were missionaries in Japan with the Evangelical Free Church for seven years.

Dr. Payne authored *Man and Woman, One in Christ: An Exegetical and Theological Study of Paul's Letters* (2009). He is well known for his scholarship in the areas of New Testament textual criticism, the parables of Jesus, and man & woman in the Pauline writings.

Dr. Payne is also the founder and president of Linguist's Software, Inc.

He and Nancy have three children: David, Kimiko, and Brendan.
