Easter and Ministry are about Arnies! This week, Don Murdoch (Carolyn), assistant pastor at Abby Free emailed me about a baptism to be held Easter Sunday in their church.

Don is 77 years old. He served in the R.C.A.F., and after retiring from this, he and Carolyn pastored in the EFCC. Retiring from this, they moved to Abbotsford, where they have volunteered at Abby Free, as ministers to seniors.

Arnie, who will be baptized on Sunday is 80 years old. He had no Christian teaching growing up. His parents called themselves Lutheran but never attended church. His first marriage was to a Catholic lady and with this, he joined the

Catholic Church and studied the Catholic doctrine but never learned about a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Later, he remarried, this time to a lady with children, and this immediately gave him a family of 2 step daughters, 5 grand children and 5 great grandchildren!

God has used people in Arnie's life from Abby Free in different ways over the years. One couple were his landlords. Another couple were his neighbors. He was invited to men's breakfasts, and also out to breakfast on several occasions by two men in the church where they shared Jesus with him.

Arnie joined a Bible Study, on the "Purpose Driven Life" at Pastor Don and Carolyn Murdoch's home, and over the next forty weeks, along with two other men, learned as he says "his purpose for being created and how he was created to serve God." He also started reading the Bible each day.

Arnie cannot give an exact date on which he received Christ, but as he says, "his eighty year old mind does not allow him to remember those things" but he felt his life change from the inside and knew he wanted to follow Jesus. A time when he wanted to make Jesus Lord of his Life. Arnie

knows he wants to be baptized - "to die to his old self and proclaim his new life in Christ.

Christ came for people like Arnie - like you and me - and like our neighbours. May we have opportunity to share the good news of our risen Saviour with our families and friends.

We may never know until heaven what impact our sharing the Good News will have. Evangelism is a team effort!
