What's God Up To In Our LPD Family? Serving Sally - in the Name of Jesus!

On Thursday, I had the opportunity to meet with Island pastors and church leaders, as we conducted a workshop on implementing the new BC Societies Act in our churches. It was a joy to be with our island friends at this event, hosted by Rick and Sandy McAllister at Wildwood Community Church, and organized by our LPD Island Church Liaison, Ben (Anna) Crumback of Sointula Community Church.

While there, it was great to catch up, and to learn what God is doing in various churches. I was particularly struck by the story of Joel and Ingrid Chiri, who pastor The Rock Christian Fellowship in Ladysmith. Their story is an example and encouragement to us all! Joel writes: Sally was a street person that attended the Rock (so to speak). She lived in a shack near the Church with no bath and little water. She was banned from the grocery store, liquor store, various restaurants. She was only allowed into the Eagle's Hall because of the Rock. She would come and get coffee and a little food. She would always leave when the Church started until one night 'Gord' another street person that professes Christ, and came to the meetings, asked her "Sally are you going to stay for Church or just eat and run away again?" She told him to shut up but started staying for parsing the service. She would get her coffee and a little food, then go for a few minutes, then

come and sit in the service again. As people got to know her she warmed up to us and would tease or joke a little. Recently, she came and got her coffee and a little food and left as usual. On her return, she collapsed at the door and died.

The Rock has doctors and nurses that attend and they tried to revive her but failed. We decided the little street lady should be remembered and we planned a memorial. Her memorial turned into a wonderful community outreach with between 100 and 120 people attending. Person after person came forward to tell what she meant to them or how they had tried to share Jesus with her. Many said if an unwanted person could find a Church that wanted to remember her they wanted to attend that kind of Church. The Rock in reaching out to her had an opportunity to reach out to a large portion of the entire community. Whether people liked her or not they thought the Rock was great to remember someone like her. We found out that Sally was almost 75 years old and we found some of her family living on the Island. We contacted them and they tearfully attended the memorial. One lady from the Rock who plays various instruments said, Sally, had asked: "if she paid her would she play Amazing Grace on the violin for her." She said, of course, no charge. The first song of the memorial was Sally's favorite Amazing Grace. Thanks for your ministry in the Name of Jesus in Ladysmith, people of the Rock!
