The Cruise provides for a day together for LPD pastors, ministry staff and colleagues in the EFCC. It is a day out of the office, a day for investing in developing deeper relationships with co-workers in ministry - relationships that will sustain us in the days ahead. *You need this, and your colleagues need you!*

Here's the plan:

On Wednesday, May 31th, Island pastors and staff plan to meet at Duke Point (Nanaimo) and travel together on the 10:15 AM ferry to Tsawwassen. At Tsawwassen, mainland pastors and staff will join us for the 12:45 PM return trip to Duke Point (Nanaimo). This will give both island and lower mainland pastors and staff more than two hours together individually, as well as a valuable couple of hours as a whole group. Mainlanders will then return to Tsawwassen on the 3:15 PM sailing.

The major goal of the day is our fellowship, prayer and encouragement together. There will be opportunities for both formal and informal interaction with fellow pastors and staff. It will be an opportunity to say farewell to **Evans and Donnae Hundermark**, who will be leaving Mountain View Church in Sardis for Foremost EFC in southern Alberta. In addition, we will be following up on our LPD Conference theme of Revitalize:

- As you know, **“Revitalize”** is a joint initiative of the entire EFCC. **It is about living and sharing the Gospel.** The “revitalize theme” began with a deep conviction birthed in our EFCC leadership meetings last June. The relevance of this theme was confirmed by the survey of pastors and churches conducted last fall. We recognize our need to be Gospel-centred people.
- At our district conference, **Phil Harris** of Johnston Heights Church presented on this theme. Since then, we have dialogued, have processed your input and suggestions, and now present to you **Principles of Harvest** for sharing the Gospel and resources for implementation in your local church.
- Please join us as we follow up from conference, and as we learn where we go from here to equip people for harvest.

Islanders, please plan to arrive at the Duke Point terminal by 9:45 AM, to catch the 10:15 AM ferry. Mainlanders, please plan to meet at the Tsawwassen Terminal by 12:15 PM! We will gather at the foot passenger entrance. **Fares** are \$17.45 per person each way (includes Nanaimo Port Fee). Mainlanders, we have booked a group fare of \$29.05 per person return (includes Nanaimo Port Fee) each way. Please have exact fare ready for Josephine.
